We provide product solutions of the highest quality for our customers nationally and regionally.



For years, CN has supported the Lebanese Red Cross to secure an additional Emergency Medical Services (EMS) unit, which serves Beirut district.


The Red Cross are also supported by CN for their continuous services in the North as well as in other regions.

SABEH SPORTS ACADEMY





BREATHING LIFE INTO HISTORY - SIDON ARCHEOLOGICAL DIG

In addition to our community service, we are also dedicated to CSR projects on a national level. The ongoing British Museum / Department of Antiquities of Lebanon Excavation in Sidon has been in operation since 1998. The city's stratigraphical sequence encountered and the continuity of occupation from the end of the 4th Millennium B.C. to the medieval period is exceptional. This will undoubtedly lay the foundations for a chronological dating sequence for Lebanon as a whole that has not yet been established.









ENVIRONMENT & HERITAGE DAY

CN continuously welcomes more than 150 school children from the villages surrounding its Chekka Plant, all the way to the villages in the Koura region. The children have many discussions about the

environment, how to be eco-friendly and the heritage of the Enfeh region. CN also presents its ideas to safeguard the environment.

GREEN BELT PROJECT

In 2014, CN implemented the first quarry integration project in Lebanon.

The Green Belt consists of a non-exploited green field area that surrounds the quarry. Its advantages extend from the ecological and agricultural to the social and economic levels.

This project was studied by Eco-Med France and implemented according to international norms, biodiversity and conservation procedures after discussing the community's expectation.

Students from different universities were attracted to this innovative project and wrote their theses on it.









SUMMER FESTIVALS: CHEKKA, ENFEH, BATROUN

For many years, CN sponsored the annual Chekka Summer Festival, that is organized by the Chekka Development Council. Hundreds of participants of all ages attended the festival to enjoy the many cultural, entertainment and sports activities. Medals and cups were awarded to the winners of football and volleyball tournaments, as well as races and marathons. Comedy shows, painting symposium, cultural, entertainment, sports activities and many other animations are held during the annual summer festivals organized in Enfeh, Chekka, Batroun and Kelhat. Hundreds of citizens from

the surrounding villages and from all ages attend these festivals to enjoy their time.






MAAN NOHAKIK CAMPAIGN
